“I perceived that whatever God does endures forever...” (Ecclesiastes 3:14).

Dear fellow Christ followers,

Recently I have been studying the book of Ecclesiastes for a Men’s Bible Study at our church. Ecclesiastes 3:14, partially quoted above, reminds us of a precious truth: *Whatever God does endures forever!* That is certainly also true of your investment in Tri-M and the many local church leaders with whom God has joined us in supplying resources to consistently train them from God’s Word, the Bible.

MONGOLIA

It seems God has opened the door to return to Mongolia to join our Mongolian teaching team in person after two years of COVID-related travel restrictions and remote Zoom sessions. Thus far there have been a variety of complications with our travel arrangements that have surfaced then been resolved. However, in the midst of it all, we still are on target to have two adjunct supporting American pastors and myself make the September 2022 trip. Please join us in prayer for the final details to fall into place and that God gives us discernment to sense His leading and to adapt

where necessary. Our flight connections have changed twice, but the Lord has allowed us (Pastors Keith Treadway and David Sincock and me) to avoid an overnight stay en route to Seoul, Korea that would mean added paperwork and more hoops to jump through in order to stay on schedule. We are praying that this scenario remains intact. COVID testing remains a possibility with our travel schedule—even at our eventual departure from Mongolia. Please pray that we will recognize and follow God’s leading in all of these situations.

There are still various obstacles in Mongolia for the church leaders who attend the training sessions. Pray that

they and their families will see God’s hand in working through the details and so be encouraged. The training will mark the completion of the curriculum for the two groups of students by the end of next year, Lord willing. That will make six full groups, so far, that have completed the curriculum in Mongolia!

Also join us in prayer for sensitivity, especially among the Mongolian leadership, to embrace leading future training sessions on their own after these groups have graduated.

EAST AFRICA

Throughout East Africa, plans are being made by the local leadership to continue

Tri-M training completely independently. All four East African countries—Tanzania, Uganda, Kenya, and South Sudan—to which you have allowed us to introduce the Tri-M concept, plan to time their training sessions with the beginning of each respective country’s 2022 “academic year.”

Tanzania has plans for five new training sites this fall, and as I write this



report, Uganda is hosting 101 church leaders for three weeks of training and will be calling them back in a few months for a second training session lasting two to three weeks. South Sudanese leaders are constantly traveling to the various refugee camps in Uganda whenever they can. Graduates are still reporting a great



response to Bible-centered preaching, even among the youngest preachers.

These young pastors were not the usual church leaders before fleeing battle-torn South Sudan. It was Tri-M training and SSEST (South Sudan Evangelical School of Theology) in the refugee camps that opened the door for them to provide hope from the Scriptures in their seemingly hopeless situation. They are the ones who operate and staff the churches



within the camps that still are growing and ministering in the name of Christ. The Lord willing, Western Kenya will soon restart a training program with their Church Planters Internship in place and work with two seasoned village church planters for the next group of students.

Your investment in Tri-M is still reaping eternal benefits around the
